Product Description:

H.D. Degreaser is a caustic blend-based highly active, waterborne degreaser for cleaning and degreasing oil contaminated as well as greasy surfaces. It has very strong emulsifying power for a broad range of contaminants (oil, grease, lubricants, animal fats, etc). It is odorless and works well on concrete as well as ferrous surfaces.

Application Guidelines:

Spray the surface to be degreased with H.D. Degreaser (or it's dilution) and rub the contamination loose with a hard brush. 1-part Heavy Duty Degreaser can be diluted in 5 to 20 litres of fresh water depending on surface condition. OR rub in the surface to be degreased with cloth (or sponge) moistened with H.D. Degreaser (or it's dilution). Then rinse the surface with water to remove all contaminations. Let the cleaned surface dry or blast it with dry compressed air.

Packaging:

Available in 10 litres, 25 litres and 200 litres packaging.

Storage & Shelf life:

Products shall be ideally stored in a cool, dry location in unopened containers at a temperature between 8° to 28°C (46° to 82°F) unless otherwise labelled. Optimal storage is at the lower half of this temperature range. To prevent contamination of unused products, do not return any material to its original container.
